The City of Los Angeles Charter Bus Program is designed to assist senior, youth, and disabled groups in the City of Los Angeles with free or subsidized charter bus services to attend education, recreational, or cultural events in the region. Service is provided on coach, school, and wheelchair accessible vehicles, and is available throughout the year on a first-come, first served basis.
